

Lifeguard Supervisor

The WSI must have 3 years of lifeguard experience and a minimum of 2 years supervisory experience.

They must be creative and enthusiastic with children, to be a positive role model, have the ability to communicate with a diverse group of individuals, and be reliable and punctual. Preference will be given to individuals who have previously taught swim lessons, volunteered or been employed in a leadership role.

A WSI must have a current Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certificate or other certificate from a recognized organization.

Job Responsibilities/Expectations include (but are not limited to)

- Managing the scheduling and performance of all lifeguards during the summer at the pool.
- Training all lifeguards on policy and procedures.
- Following up with pool patron's concerns.
- Swim lessons for rising 1st-2nd grade campers.
- Private swim lessons to children of pool patrons.
- Supervise children at all times in all areas of the pool.
- Inspect the pool site and equipment daily and alert Director to any potential safety.
- Vacuum pool liner and empty pool filters daily.
