Applicants must be over 18 years old. Applicants must have demonstrated knowledge pertaining to camping, fishing, hiking, natural history, local flora and fauna, and wildlife. This position is an 8am – 5pm position with the expectation that hour may vary to meet the needs of camp.

Job Responsibilities include (but not limited to)

- Develop age appropriate activities that keep children active and help them develop skills, teamwork and passion for learning.
- Responsible for up to 15 children per group. Use group management skills to engage all children in daily activities
- Use unassigned time for planning activities and review with the Program Director. The expectation is that plans are to be designed for the following weekly session at camp.
- During day camp weeks this position may be required to prepare offsite adventures that are near camp but not on property. These activities would be for our older age groups and would be a half day trip.
- During overnight camp weeks this position may be required to write plans for overnight camp staff to utilize.
- Maintain standards which promote the health and safety of all participants.
